
Should sustainable tourism products be actually capable of attracting visitors by ensuring the lower possible carbon footprint on the environment?

Bologna - Monteveglio

Route one connects the Capital of Emilia-Romagna Region, starting from the monumental and tourist heart of Bologna, with the ancient "PiccolaCassia" path.

Gaggio Montano – Porretta Terme

This route connects the ancient path of the "Piccola Cassia" to the main town of the upper Reno valley, "Porretta Terme", in the Tuscan-Emilian Apennines, passing through ancient chestnut groves and crossing the mountain production area of "Parmigiano-Reggiano DOP"


