





The physical installation consists in a new historical and cultural route in the HQ of the Port of Trieste, divided into two sections:

- HQ entrance main meeting room (3rd floor)
- "Sala Colonne" (ground floor)

The main physical exhibition is located on the ground floor and it includes pictures and objects and QR code liking to the ADRIJO platform.

CONCLUSION — NEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR TOURISM learned from VM

1) ROLE OF PORTS

Ports can also contribute to the development of tourism - new way to discover cities through the VM Adrijo, created on the basis of the historical - cultural heritage of the Ports

2) NEW DIGITAL TOOLS

- it is possible to reach bigger target of potential interested people at transnational level
- can reach also who for various reasons, such as physical and other impediments, are unable to visit Ports and cities physically
- sustainable tourism

3) NETWORKING - One of the most important result and the key discovered during the project activities – create a touristic network not only at local, but also at transnational level – α network that can be constantly expanded and offers a cross-border cultural exchange that can only enrich its members
