Ljubljana Castle through time

15th century – built as a fortress

16th **century** – seat of the provincial governor

17th and 18th century – gradual decline (barracks, armoury, warehouse)

19th century – state penitentiary



Renovation & revitalisation

- 1905 castle is purchased by the city
- 1969 beginning of renovation
- 1986 castle was pronounced a cultural monument
- 1999 Festival Ljubljana manages the partially renovated castle



From the very beginning of the renovation, experts from the City Museum of Ljubljana and the Institute for the Protection of the Cultural Heritage of Slovenia were included in the project.


Main challenges

- preservation and promotion of castle's tangible and intangible heritage



Tangible and intangible cultural heritage of Ljubljana Castle is the foundation of the Institute's cultural and tourist offer.



Former prison transformed into a youth hostel. More than 80 artists from all over the world took part in renovation.










